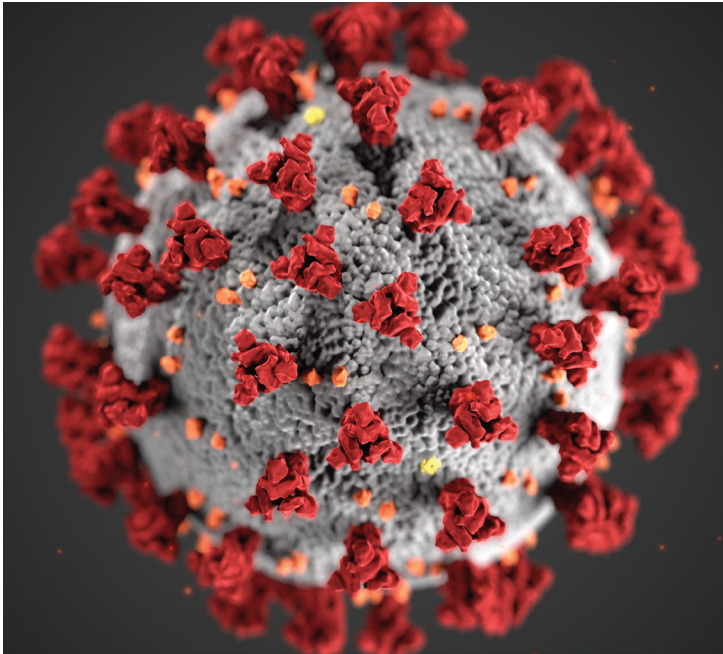


COVID-19

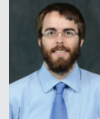
