

Telehealth Consent: Verbal Confirmation From Patient At Time Of Visit

“Before we start, I need to get your consent because we are meeting over (video/telephone), what some people call telehealth.”

“Telehealth is a way for you to talk with me from any place, including home. Because you don’t have to come to my clinic, you won’t risk getting sick from other people. You can use telehealth to talk with me by phone or computer, and we can use video to see each other.”

“As usual, we will bill your insurance for the appointment, and your information will be kept private in the medical record.”
