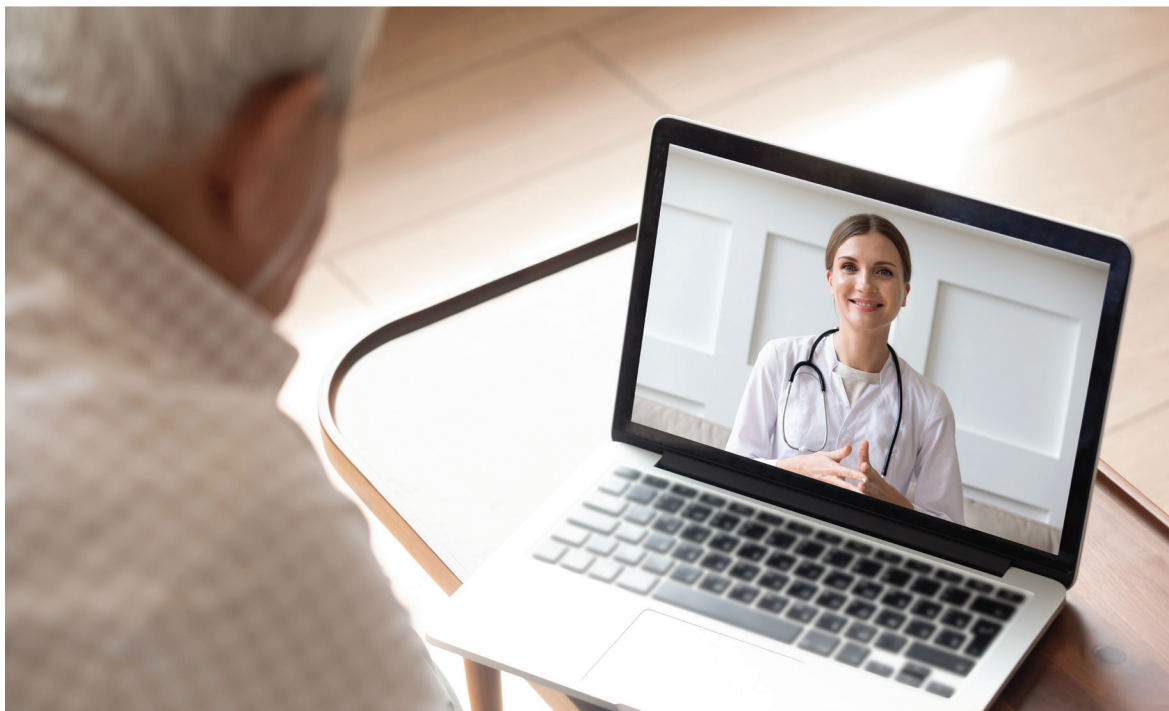


# Telemedicine ECHO

- Evaluating Your Program

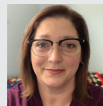

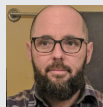
