ECHO uses videoconferencing to connect interdisciplinary teams of subject matter experts. These ECHO hopes to assist CHW's with providing a safe, nurturing environment for exchanging knowledge and sharing experiences to strengthen and support the families and communities they serve. These virtual, case-based learning sessions occur **every 1st and 3rd Tuesday of the month from 2:00-3:00 p.m.** at no cost to participating sites or individuals. Eligible professionals may also qualify for continuing education credits.
